CHAPTER 139.

[Published April 28, 1866.]

AN ACT to amend section one, chapter seventy-five (75) of the revised statutes, entitled "of the incorporation of mutual, saving, trust, loan and building associations."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amendment.

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter seventy-five (75) of the revised statutes, is hereby amended, by inserting after the word "purchased," where it occurs in said section, the following: "or for the purpose of building and keeping in repair a hall to be used for holding political, religious, temperance or scientific discussions in, and all meetings that will tend to promote the best interests and general intelligence of the people."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 140.

AN ACT to amend sections 3 and 5 of chapter 203 of the general laws of 1859, entitled "an act to amend chapter 10 of the revised statutes, 'of state efficers,' and chapter 23 of the revised statutes, 'of common schools.'"

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation to state superintendent for trayeling expenses.

SECTION 1. Sec. 3 of chap. 203 of the general laws of 1859, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "There is hereby appropriated annually to the superintendent of public instruction, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one thousand dollars, to defray the traveling expenses in making official visits, as required by law; said appropriation to be drawn in such sums and at such times as the state superintendent may elect."
