CHAPTER 86.

AN ACT to amend chapter 31 of the general laws of 1868, entitled "an act in relation to county supervisors in counties containing less than three towns."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 31 of the general laws of 1868, ^{Amended.} entitled "an act in relation to county supervisors in counties containing less than three towns," is hereby amended by adding after section 3, the following, viz: "Section 4. The boards of supervisors elected under the provisions of this act, shall, at their first meeting in January, choose by ballot, one of their number as chairman of the board for one year," and that section 4 is hereby changed to section 5, and section 5 is hereby changed to section 6.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
