

CHAPTER 108.

[Published March 22, 1871.]

AN ACT to appropriate to Andrew Proudfit and James K. Proudfit the sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of Appropriated. any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of twelve thousand dollars to Andrew Proudfit, assignee of Elias A. Calkins and to James K. Proudfit, which is to be in full of all demands or claims of any nature arising or growing out of a contract for printing, made by Beriah Brown with the state, and by him assigned to Elias A. Calkins and James K. Proudfit upon which a suit is now pending in the supreme court of this state.

SECTION 2. The secretary of state is hereby authorized to draw his warrant for the sum, upon the state treasury, upon receipt by him of a release from said Andrew Proudfit and James K. Proudfit, or their assigns of all claims of any name or nature, upon or growing out of a suit or a contract, upon which the same is based, wherein the said Andrew Proudfit and James K. Proudfit are plaintiffs and the state of Wisconsin defendant, whether such claim arises from interest, costs or otherwise. Secretary to draw warrant

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
