

CHAPTER 157.

[Published March 29, 1871.]

AN ACT to amend chapter [156] of general laws of 1871, entitled "an act to apportion the state into senate and assembly districts."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended.

SECTION 1. That the towns of Black Wolf, Omro, Algoma, in the county of Winnebago, and the third and sixth wards of the city of Oshkosh, shall constitute an assembly district.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 158.

[Published April 1, 1871.]

AN ACT to amend section ten of chapter 77 of the general laws of 1866, entitled "an act for the regulation of trade in certain cases."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended.

SECTION 1. Section 10 of chapter 77 of the general laws of 1866, is hereby amended to read as follows: "Section 10. The fees for overhauling, inspecting, re-packing and branding, shall be, for each barrel, sixty cents; for each half barrel, thirty cents, inclusive of cooperage, which fees shall be paid by the person employing such inspectors."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
