AN ACT to repeal chapter 174 of the general laws of 1869, an act entitled an act to amend chapter 49 of the general laws of 1866, entitled an act to amend sections 1 and 4 of chapter 133 of the revised statutes, entitled "of costs and fees," and to revise [revive] and re-enact chapter 18 of the general laws of 1867, an act entitled an act to amend chapter 49 of the general laws of 1866, entitled an act to amend sections 1 and 4 of chapter 133 of the revised statutes, entitled "of costs and fees."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 174 of the general laws of 1869, an act to amend chapter 49 of the general laws of 1866, entitled an act to amend sections 1 and 4 of chapter 133 of the revised statutes, entitled "of costs and fees," is hereby repealed. Repealed.

SECTION 2. Chapter 18 of the general laws of 1867, an act entitled an act to amend chapter 49 of the general laws of 1866, entitled an act to amend sections 1 and 4 of chapter 133 of the revised statutes, entitled "of costs and fees," is hereby revived, re-enacted and of full force. Revived.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 8.

[Published February 14, 1871.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 122, general laws, 1868, entitled "an act to provide for highways in recorded village plats."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That section one of said act be amended by adding immediately after the words, "public high- Amended.

way," of the last line of said section, "and to vacate any street or alley in such recorded plat upon petition signed by at least ten resident freeholders of said village."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 9.

[Published February 14, 1871.]

AN ACT to regulate the time of holding the general terms of the circuit court for the sixth judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended.

Terms fixed.

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter two of the general laws of 1869 is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "The general terms of the circuit court for the sixth judicial circuit shall hereafter be held as follows: in the county of Clark, on the first Tuesday of March and the first Tuesday of September in each year; in the county of Jackson, on the second Tuesday of March and second Tuesday of September in each year; in the county of Monroe, on the fourth Tuesday of March and the fourth Tuesday of September in each year; in the county of Trempealeau, on the third Tuesday of April and the second Tuesday of October in each year; in the county of Buffalo, on the first Tuesday of May and the fourth Tuesday of October in each year; in the county of La Crosse, on the second Tuesday of May and the second Tuesday of November in each year, and in the county of Vernon, on the second Tuesday of June and the first Tuesday after the second Monday of December in each year."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
