

CHAPTER 239.

AN ACT to authorize John M. Robinson to maintain certain dams, piers and booms in the Wisconsin river.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authority to build and maintain dams, piers and booms.

SECTION 1. John M. Robinson, his successors, heirs and assigns are hereby authorized and empowered to construct, repair and maintain in the Wisconsin river on sections six (6), seven (7) and eight (8), township No. twenty-three (23) north, of range No. eight (8) east of the fourth principal meridian, in the county of Portage, all the dams, piers and booms now erected and built, or which he or they may hereafter erect for the use of said Robinson's mill; *provided*, such dams, piers or booms shall not obstruct or hinder the safe navigation of said river for the running of logs or lumber.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT to construe section 26 of chapter 94 of the revised statutes, entitled "of the sale of land for the payment of debts by executors, administrators and guardians."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Explanatory.

SECTION 1. It is and was the true intent and meaning of section 26 of chapter 94 of the revised statutes, that the same shall and should be applicable to sales made either under that chapter or under chapter 93 of said statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication.
