

## CHAPTER 86.

[Published March 5, 1874.]

AN ACT relating to and amendatory of section 1 of chapter 198 of the laws of Wisconsin of 1873, entitled "an act to provide for the collection of the taxes therein named in certain cases, to explain the meaning thereof, and to legalize certain acts of town boards of supervisors in the state of Wisconsin."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. That section 1 of chapter 198 of the laws of Wisconsin of 1873, entitled "an act to provide for the collection of taxes therein named in certain cases," be, and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words, "the first day of February," in the fourth and fifth lines of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the words, "the third day of March."

Extending time for collecting taxes in certain cases.

SECTION 2. That it is the true intent and meaning of said section 1, to in no manner abridge, alter or take from the boards of supervisors of the several towns in this state, the power of extending the time for the collection of taxes as delegated in section 65 of chapter 18 of the revised statutes of 1858, but that said power remain in said boards of supervisors, as fully as if said section one had not been enacted.

Powers of town boards not impaired.

SECTION 3. That all acts of the boards of supervisors of the several towns in this state in extending the time for the collection of taxes under section 65 of chapter 18 of the revised statutes of 1858, for the taxes of 1873, be, and the same are hereby made as valid and effectual as if said section 1 of chapter 198 of the laws of Wisconsin of 1873 had not been enacted.

Act of town boards legalized.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
