CHAPTER 105.

[Published March 10, 1876.]

AN ACT to authorize Dudley J. Spaulding to maintain dams across the north and south forks of Popple river and Brett creek, in Clark county.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authority to erect dams.

SECTION 1. Dudley J. Spaulding, his heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized to erect, maintain, and keep up dams across the north and south forks of Popple river, and across Brett creek at the following points, viz: Dam number one (1), on section seventeen (17), town twenty-seven (27), range one (1) east of the fourth principal meridian; dam number two (2), on sections twenty-three (23) and twenty-six (26), town twenty-eight (28), range one (1) east; dam number three (3), on section thirty-six (36), town twenty-nine (29), range two (2) west; and dam number four (4), on sections twenty-two (22) and twenty-three (23), town twenty-nine (29), range one (1) west of meridian aforesaid, Clark county, for the purpose of facilitating the running of logs to Black river.

Shall build slide and gates.

SECTION 2. The said Dudley J. Spaulding, his heirs and assigns, shall build suitable slides and gates in said dams, for flooding purposes, and for the purpose of sluicing and driving logs over, through and beyond said dams into Black river, and shall keep the same in repair, and shall hold the water back for the above named purposes, whenever the case may require, and for that purpose said gates shall be closed.

Term of grant.

SECTION 3. The aforesaid Dudley J. Spaulding, his heirs and assigns, shall enjoy the privileges granted in this act for the term of fifteen years.

Rates of toll.

SECTION 4. When the said Dudley J. Spaulding, his heirs and assigns shall have completed said dams as aforesaid, they are hereby authorized and empowered to receive and collect from the owners of all logs passing over such slides, or driven by the aid of such

dams, as a compensation for keeping up and maintaining such dams, as follows: On all logs put into said south fork, the sum of ten cents (10) per thousand feet, board measure; on all logs put into said north fork, the sum of seven cents (07) per thousand feet; and on all logs put into Popple river, below said forks and down to the north north line of section twenty-four (24), town twenty-eight (28), range two (2) west, the sum of five cents (5) per thousand feet, the amount to be ascertained by scale, on the landing in the woods; and the aforesaid Dudley J. Spaulding, his heirs and assigns, shall have a lien on all logs run over said dams, or driven by the aid thereof, until the aforesaid charges shall be fully paid, which lien may be enforced in the same manner in which other liens are enforced under the general laws of the State of Wisconsin, or the lien-laws applicable to Clark county; *provided*, that the said Dudley J. Spaulding, his heirs and assigns, shall at all times comply with the provisions of section (2) of this act.

SECTION 5. The control of said dams, slides, and gates shall belong to said Dudley J. Spaulding, his heirs and assigns, but subject always to the provisions of section two (2) of this act. Control of dams.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 106.

[Published March 8, 1876.]

AN ACT to authorize and require the county clerk of the county of Burnett to make and keep up an abstract of tax sales.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the county clerk of the county of Burnett to make an abstract of tax sales of said county, and to post and note therein all sales made by said county for taxes, and to note therein, in a conspicuous manner, all deeds and redemptions, and to procure books for that purpose, to be paid for from the county treasury; and as compensation for such service the said clerk shall be paid the sum County clerk to make abstract of tax sales.
