

CHAPTER 136.

[Published March 13, 1876.]

AN ACT to amend section 2, of chapter 120, of the general laws of 1862, in relation to county surveyors.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Fees of surveyor.

SECTION 1. Section 2, of chapter 120, of the general laws of 1862, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: The said surveyor and his deputies may demand and receive for their services the following fees, to-wit: For each day's service three dollars; for each mile traveled in going from his office to the place of rendering such service, and in returning, ten cents; for a plat and certificate, except town plats, fifty cents; for recording a survey, fifty cents, except as when otherwise agreed upon between the parties.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 137.

[Published March 13, 1876.]

AN ACT to amend section six (6), of chapter one hundred and thirty-four (134), of the revised statutes, entitled, "Of executions and proceedings supplementary thereto."

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appointment of referee.

SECTION 1. Section six (6), of chapter one hundred and thirty-four, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended, by adding the following words at the end of said section; *provided*, such referee shall not be appointed by the court until the plaintiff in the action, or his attorney, shall, by affidavit, satisfy the court that the sheriff of the county where such premises are situate, is a party to such sale, or has a pecuniary interest in the premises or real property to be sold.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
