

CHAPTER 323.

[Published March 21, 1876.]

AN ACT to appropriate to the Milwaukee Industrial School, a sum of money therein named.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Milwaukee Industrial School, the sum of one thousand dollars, out of the general fund, for the maintenance of the children kept and maintained therein. Appropriation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 324.

[Published March 21, 1876.]

AN ACT to appropriate to the St. Nazian Society, of the county of Manitowoc, a sum of money.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. It is hereby appropriated to the St. Nazian Society, of the county of Manitowoc, the sum of five hundred dollars, out of any money not otherwise appropriated. Appropriation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
