CHAPTER 325.

[Published March 21, 1876.]

AN ACT to appropriate to Reuben May a sum of money to cover his expenses in contested election case.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation.

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of three hundred dollars, to pay the expenses of the contestant in the case of the contest for the office of senator for the 4th senatorial district, at the present session of the senate, and it is ordered that said amount be paid to Reuben May, for that purpose.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 326.

[Published March 21, 1876.]

AN ACT to appropriate to the St. Joseph's Orphan Asylum a sum of money therein named.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation.

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the St. Joseph's Orphan Asylum, of Milwaukee, the sum of five hundred dollars out of the general fund, for the maintenance of orphans.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
