## CHAPTER 149.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "an act to consolidate and amend the act to incorporate the city of Berlin, and the several acts amendatory thereof."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter four of chapter three hundred and six of the private and local laws of 1868, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new section, to wit: Section 17. The city council is hereby authorized to enter into any contract or take any conveyance which they may deem expedient and for the general good, relative to any lands owned by Mary A. Harrington, adjoining the cemetery in said city, on the north; and after the execution of any such contract or conveyance, it shall be lawful for said city to use, or permit to be used, such land for cemetery purposes. The plat of any lands laid out for cemetery purposes in pursuance of the provisions of this section, after being duly acknowledged, shall be filed in the city clerk's office, and deeds of lots as numbered upon said plat, shall be sufficient. Such deeds shall specify the purpose for which the lots are to be used, and shall be recorded by the city clerk in a book kept by him for that purpose. His fees for recording such deeds shall be the same as allowed to registers of deeds; and the said records and copies thereof, duly certified by him, shall be received as evidence in all courts and places in like manner as the originals.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
