guage does confer upon such board of regents, or such board of trustees, as the case may be, power and authority to authorize, in their discretion, any president or faculty employed by them to suspend, expel or otherwise properly discipline any pupil attending any such educational institution of which they may be in charge.

Section 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 227.

AN ACT to provide for the transfer of the normal school fund income to the treasurer of the board of regents of normal schools.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The entire income of the normal school Transfer of funds. fund shall be placed at the disposal of the board of regents of normal schools by transfer to the treasurer of said board, thenceforth to be distinct and independent of the accounts of the state and for the support of normal schools as provided by law.

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent Repealed. with this act are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 228.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and ninety-nine of the laws of Wisconsin for 1877, entitled "An act to amend chapter three hundred and eleven, private and local laws of 1867, entitled an act to incorporate the Pete-en-Well bridge company, and also to authorize certain towns to grant aid therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one (1) of said chapter two Amended. hundred and ninety-nine of the laws of Wisconsin for
