CHAPTER 25.

AN ACT to appropriate to the Institute for the Education of the Deaf and Dumb a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Appropriation. Institute for the Education of the Deat and Dumb, out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of thirty thousand dollars, being in full for current expenses, improvements and miscellaneous purposes for the year ending February 28, 1879.

SECTION 2. All sums of money appropriated by

this act may be drawn quarterly in advance.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 26.

AN ACT to amend section five of chapter ninety-eight of the laws of Wisconsin, approved February twenty-eight, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, entitled, "An act regulating the salary of the county judge of Milwaukee county."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section five of chapter ninety-eight of Amendment. the laws of the state of Wisconsin for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 5. All acts and parts of acts conflicting with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed; provided, however, that the provisions of this act shall not apply to cases and matters pending and undetermined in said county court of Milwaukee county in probate, on the thirty-first day of December, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven; provided further, however, that the Proviso. fees for services done by the county judge and clerk in such cases and matters after that date, shall be paid into the county treasury.
