## CHAPTER 305.

AN ACT to appropriate to the institution for the education of the blind a sum of money therein named, and to repeal chapter sixty-six of the laws of Wisconsin of 1878.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the institution for the education of the blind, out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of eighteen thousand five hundred dollars for the following purposes, to-wit: Seventeen thousand five hundred and forty-five dollars for the payment of current expenses for the year ending March 1st, 1879, four hundred and fifty-five dollars for house furnishing, five hundred dollars for improvement of grounds.

Disbursement of funds.

SECTION 2. All sums of money appropriated by this act for current expenses shall be drawn not oftener than quarterly in advance.

Repealed.

SECTION 3. Chapter sixty-six of the laws of Wisconsin of 1878, approved March 4, 1878, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 306.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled an Act to incorporate the Germantown Farmer's Mutual Fire Insurance Company, approved April 1st, 1854, and amendatory of chapter three hundred and thirty-one of the private and local laws of the year 1857, and all acts amendatory thereto.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Members.

Section 1. All persons who shall at any time insure in said company, and also their respective heirs, executors, administrators and assigns continuing to be insured therein, shall be members thereof during the continuance of their respective policies, and no longer, and shall at all times be concluded and bound by the provisions of this act.
