CHAPTER 331.

AN ACT for the relief of the holders of street commissioners' certificates, issued by the street commissioners of the city of Oconto in 1875 and 1876.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. It is hereby made the duty of the treasurer of the city of Oconto, in Oconto county, in this state, to redeem and take up all certificates issued by the several boards of street commissioners of said city in 1875 and 1876, and pay the holders of said street commissioners' certificates, for such redemption, the face value of said street commissioners' certificates in tax certificates of said county, at the face value of said tax certificates. And for the purpose of more fully carrying out the purposes of this act, the holders of said street commissioners' certificates shall, within sixty days from and after the publication of this act, file with the treasurer of said city a list of the street commissioners' certificates owned by them, and a list of the tax certificates claimed by them in exchange for their said street commissioners' certificates, and the treasurer of said city shall immediately give, or cause to be given, to the county treasurer of said county, a certified copy of said lists, which certified lists shall be filed with the county treasurer of said county, within five days after filing the original thereof with said city treasurer, and the said county treasurer shall reserve, for the purpose of this act, said tax certificates so selected, and deliver the same to the said city treasurer for the use of the holders of said street commissioners' certificates for the purpose of fully carrying out the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
