CHAPTER 48.

AN ACT to appropriate to the Northern Wisconsin Agricultural and Mechanical Association, a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Appropriation. Northern Wisconsin Agricultural and Mechanical Association, out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one thousand dollars, for the promotion and advancement of the industrial interests of the state.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 49.

AN ACT to amend chapter eighty-nine of the laws of 1877, entitled "an act to incorporate the city of Chilton.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter eighty-nine of the laws of 1877, Amended. entitled "An act to incorporate the city of Chilton," is hereby amended as follows, to-wit: Wherever the words "first Tuesday after the first Monday in April" occur in said act, the same shall be amended by substituting in the place and stead thereof the words "first Tuesday in April."

SECTION 2. The twenty-second subdivision of section three in chapter four of said act is hereby amended Amendment. so as to read as follows: "22d. To make regulations to prevent the introduction and dissemination of contagious or infectious diseases within the city, and to regulate and govern the reception and care of persons sick with such diseases, or who have recently been exposed thereto, and to make such disposition of such persons as to preserve the health of said city, and to prevent the landing of such persons from railroad cars, stages or other conveyances, within the limits of said city."
