CHAPTER 69.

AN ACT in relation to the Catfish river in the county of Dane.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Persons may remove logs, rubbish, etc. SECTION 1. It shall be lawful for any person, persons, company or corporation, at any time, to remove from the bed of the Catfish river, so-called, between the Third lake and Second lake, in the county of Dane, any dirt, sticks, stones, logs or other rubbish.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 70.

AN ACT to amend section fifty-four of chapter one hundred and thirty-seven of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one, entitled, "An act to provide for the trial of offenses upon information and to make the general laws of the state applicable thereto."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amendment.

SECTION 1. Section fifty-four of chapter one hundred and thirty-seven of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words, to wit: "But the omission of witnesses, to sign such testimony, shall not invalidate any proceedings had upon the examination, nor any information based thereon."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
