CHAPTER 74

AN ACT to appropriate to De Witt C. Fyler a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to De Appropriation Witt C. Fyler, out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of thirty-six dollars and ninety-two cents, for money paid into the state treasury for license as hawker and peddler, for which the said De Witt C. Fyler was not liable.

CHAPTER 75.

AN ACT to appropriate the sum of two hundred dollars to the Columbus Union Fair Agricultural Society and the Lodi Union Agricultural Society.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the Appropriation general fund, to the Columbus Union Fair and the Lodi wood. Union Agricultural Societies, the sum of one hundred dollars each for the year 1878.
