CHAPTER 47.

AN ACT to appropriate to the institution for the education of the deaf and dumb a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the institution for the education of the deaf and dumb, out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of fourteen thousand (14,000) dollars, to meet the current expenses of the institution to March 1, 1880, the current expense fund of the institution having been exhausted by the exigency occasioned by the burning of its main building.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 48.

AN ACT to create a municipal court for the county of Barron.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created and established in and for the county of Barron, a municipal court, with the powers and jurisdiction hereinafter specified and provided.

SECTION 2. On the first Tuesday in April, A. D. 1880, and every four years thereafter, there shall be elected in the county of Barron, in the same manner as county judges are elected, one municipal judge, who shall hold his office for the term of four years from the first Monday of May next following his election, and until his successor is elected and qualified, and in case of vacancy occurring in the office of municipal judge,
