

designated, one director for the term of three years, and one treasurer for the term of one year; also to elect by ballot at each third annual school meeting, after the school meeting of 1881 aforesaid, one clerk for the term of three years, all of whom shall constitute the board of trustees of the Mayville union school district, which said board shall also be the board of the Mayville free high school.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts conflicting with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 25.

AN ACT to provide for the purchase of four hundred copies of Webster's dictionary.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Purchase au-
thorized.

SECTION 1. The state superintendent is hereby authorized and directed to purchase, on behalf of the state, four hundred copies of the latest edition of Webster's unabridged dictionary, at a cost, delivered at his office, not to exceed seven dollars per copy.

Distribution.

SECTION 2. Said dictionaries, when procured, shall be distributed in accordance with the provisions of section five hundred and nine of the revised statutes.

Appropriation.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund a sum sufficient to pay for the dictionaries above provided for.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
