parts of acts contrary to the provisions of this act, so far as they conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 303.

AN ACT to appropriate to the Wisconsin institution for the education of the blind, certain sums of money for current expenses and special expenses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Appropriation, Wisconsin institution for the education of the blind, out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the following sums for the purposes specified, viz: For current expenses to March 1, 1882, fifteen thousand five hundred dollars; for coal vault and painting, one thousand two hundred dollars; for completing ice house, one hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 304.

AN ACT to authorize the state superintendent to fix the amount to be paid to the free high school at Stougaton, from the general fund of the state, for the year 1880.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The state superintendent is hereby Duty of state authorized and directed to fix the amount to be paid to the free high school at Stoughton, from the general fund of the state, for the year 1880, in the same manner as provided by section four hundred and ninety-six of the revised statutes, as amended by the laws of 1879, which sum is two hundred and seventy and seventy-five one-hundredths dollars, notwithstanding the neglect of the free high school to make the report to said superintendent in the manner provided by said section four hundred and ninety-six.

SECTION 2. When said amount to be paid to said Money to be free high school, shall have been so fixed by said treasurer.
