in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars for completing the transcribing of the senate journal of the present session.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated to John E. Eldred, chief clerk of the assembly, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two hundred and seventy-five dollars for completing the transcribing of the assembly journal of the present session.

SECTION 3. The money hereby appropriated shall be paid by the state treasurer on the warrants of the secretary of state, which warrants shall be issued when the duties and labor herein provided for shall have

been respectively performed.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 55.

AN ACT to legalize the acts of the Spolecna Smlouva Kossuthske town fire insurance company, comprising the towns of Gibson, Cooperstown, Franklin and Kossuth in county of Manitowoc, and state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Legalized.

Section 1. All transactions of the said Spolecna Smlouva Kossuthske town fire insurance company, comprising the towns of Gibson, Cooperstown, Franklin and Kossuth, in county of Manitowoc, and state of of Wisconsin, being a town insurance company organized under the laws of the state of Wisconsin, and located in the town of Kossuth, county of Manitowoc, state of Wisconsin, and all acts of the officers and agents, are hereby legalized and declared valid and all policies or other evidence of insurance issued by said company or its authorized officers, and all bonds, notes, mortgages or other evidence of indebtedness, executed and delivered to said company, shall be valid and binding as if all the requirements and forms of the laws of the state had been fully complied with; and no misnomer of said company shall affect the validity of any of the transactions of said company, or of documents issued or executed by such company.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force,

from and after its passage and publication.
