

and necessarily spent by them in laying out and establishing said state road, which shall be in full for all services rendered by them, and they are hereby authorized in their discretion to employ some competent surveyor to make the survey and maps herein provided for, and at such price per day as may be by them agreed upon, not exceeding five dollars per day for the time and actually necessarily employed in such work.

SECTION 4. The expenses of laying out and establishing said state road shall be borne by the said counties of Juneau and Vernon, each in proportion to the length of the said state road in each of said counties.

SECTION 5. The supervisors of each of the towns through or into which said state road or any part thereof shall be located as aforesaid are hereby directed and required to cause such part thereof as shall be located in their said town to be opened and worked and put in a fair and reasonably good and safe condition for use as a public highway within one year from the date of the filing of a copy of the plat of the survey thereof in said town and thereafter to repair, improve and maintain the same as a public highway of said town.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 280.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 297, laws of 1881, relating to divorce from the bond of matrimony.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Divorce.

SECTION 1. Chapter 297, laws of 1881, is hereby repealed. This act shall not affect any actions pending March 25, 1882, under the provisions of the act hereby repealed; but said action shall be had and judgment rendered in the same manner as though this act had not been passed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
