

wild-cat or lynx, unless the county in which said wolf, wild-cat or lynx shall be killed, shall pay to the person a reward equal to the amount named in section one (1) of this act.

SECTION 7. All acts or parts of acts contrary to the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 117.

AN ACT to appropriate eight hundred dollars (\$800) to Central Wisconsin Agricultural and Mechanical Association.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400) for the year 1883, and four hundred dollars (\$400) for the year 1884, out of any money in the treasury, to the Central Wisconsin Agricultural and Mechanical Association. Appropriation.

SECTION. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 118.

AN ACT relating to corporations, and amendatory of section 1791 of chapter 86 of the revised statutes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1791 of chapter 86 of the revised statutes, entitled, "of the organization of corporations," is hereby amended by adding thereto the following, viz.: Whenever articles of association have heretofore, and since the passage of said chapter 86, been filed in the office of the secretary of state, or in the office of the register of deeds, for any of the purposes for which corporations may be formed under said chapter 86, and an organization has been formed under and pursuant to said articles, such organization is hereby declared to be legal, and the corporation to be duly Relating to corporations.
