repealing, amending or modifying the same, unless such purpose be expressly set forth in such law. SECTION 23. This act is hereby declared to be a public act, and shall be liberally and favorably construed in all the courts of this state, and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 176.

AN ACT to amend section 50, of chapter 86, of the laws of 1883, entitled, "an act to incorporate the city of Edgerton."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amendment.

SECTION 1. Section 50, of chapter 86, of the laws of 1883, entitled, "an act to incorporate the city af Edgerton," is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "Section 50. If there should be any building, in whole or in part upon said lands to be taken, the jurors shall first estimate the value of such building to the owner, aside from the value of the land, and the injury to him in having such building taken from him; and secondly, the value of such building to him to remove."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved March 30, 1883.

CHAPTER 177.

AN ACT to incorporate the city of Mauston.

All that district of country in the county of Juneau, hereinafter described from and after the adoption of this act as hereinafter provided, shall be a city by the name of Mauston, and the people now inhabiting, and those who shall hereafter inhabit, the said district hereinafter described, shall be a municipal corporation by the
