CHAPTER 254.

AN ACT to authorize John C. Schneider to build and maintain a dam across Apple river, in the county of Polk, on the south half of the northeast quarter of section number twelve, in township number thirty-two north, of range number seventeen west.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. John C. Schneider, his associates, successors and assigns, are hereby authorized to build and maintain a dam across Apple river, in the county of Polk, and state of Wisconsin; said dam to be built on the south half of the northeast quarter of section twelve, in township thirty-two, of range seventeen; said dam to be constructed for the purpose of building threshing machines, agricultural implements and farm machinery; and to be of the height of ten feet or less.

Authorized to construct a dam.

SECTION 2. This grant is upon the condition that the said John C. Schneider, his associates, and assigns, shall build, erect and at all times maintain, in said dam, a chute or slide of the width of the chute or slide provided for in chapter 376, of the private and local laws of the year 1868, and the amendments thereto, and not less than fifty feet in length, for the purpose of running logs, lumber and timber over said dam when there is occasion for running the same.

Shall build suitable slides.

SECTION 3. The legislature hereby reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal this act whenever, in its judgment, the public interest shall so require.

Legislature reserves the right to repeal.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
