CHAPTER 283.

AN ACT to authorize John C. Schneider to build and maintain a dam across Apple river, in the county of Polk, on the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section number eleven, in township thirty-two north, of range seventeen west.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authorizing John C. Schneia dam.

SECTION 1. John C. Schneider, his associates, der to construct successors and assigns, are hereby authorized to build and maintain a dam across Apple river, in the county of Polk, in the state of Wisconsin; said dam to be built on the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section eleven, in town thirty-two, range seventeen. Said dam to be constructed for the purpose of running a flouring mill and other hydraulic purposes, of the height of fifteen feet or less.

Erect suitable slides or chutes.

SECTION 2. The said John C. Schneider, his associates, successors and assigns, as a condition of this grant, shall build, construct and at all times, maintain, at his own cost and expense, in said dam, a chute or slide of the width of the chute or slide, provided for in chapter 376, of the private and local laws of the year 1868, and the amendments thereto, and not less than fifty feet in length, for the purpose of running logs, lumber and timber over said dam when there is occasion for running the same.

Legislature reserves the right to amend or repeal this act.

Section 3. The legislature reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal this act whenever, in its judgment, the public interest shall so require.

This act shall take effect and be in SECTION 4. force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 3, 1885.
