CHAPTER 361.

AN ACT to prevent the manufacture and sale of oleaginous substances, or compounds of the same, in imitation of the pure dairy products, and to repeal sections 1 and 3, of chapter 40, of the laws of 1881.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Whoever manufactures out of any Penalty for oleaginous substances, or any compound of the spurious same, other than that produced from unadulter-butter. ated milk, or cream from the same, any article designed to take the place of butter or cheese, produced from pure, unadulterated milk, or cream of the same; or whoever shall knowingly sell, or offer for sale, the same as an article of food, shall, on conviction thereof, be confined in the county jail not exceeding one year or fined not exceeding one thousand dollars, or both.

Section 2. Sections 1 and 3, of chapter 40, of

the laws of 1881, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 8, 1885.

CHAPTER 363.

AN ACT to authorize the building of a dam across the Sheboygan river.
