CHAPTER 415.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of a license fee by the owners of palace, drawing room and sleeping car companies.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Payment of license fee from owners of palace cars demanded. SECTION 1. Section 4, of chapter 353, of the laws of 1883, entitled, "An act to provide for the payment of a license fee by the owners of palace, drawing room and sleeping car companies," is hereby amended by striking out the word, "two (2)" where it occurs in the second line of said section and inserting the word, "four (4)" so that said section when so amended shall read as follows: "Section 4. The annual license fee to be paid by such owner as aforesaid shall be four (4) per centum of the earnings reported as required by section 2 hereof; the amount of such license fee to be computed by the railroad commissioner and by him certified to the state treasurer.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 11, 1885.

AN ACT to amend section 27, of the revised statutes, relating to the division of towns into election districts.

Division of towns into election districts.

SECTION 1. Section 27, revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof, the following: The town board shall be required to make such divisions, upon the petition in writing
