CHAPTER 418.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to Mrs. Clarissa Keyes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation
to Mrs. Clarissa
Keyes.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of ninety eight dollars and eighty cents, to Mrs. Clarissa Keyes, of Spring Prairie, Walworth county, Wisconsin.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 419.

AN ACT relative to the salary of the chief engineer of the fire department, and of the deputy city clerk, of the city of Milwaukee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Salary fixed.

SECTION 1. The salary of the chief engineer of the fire department, of the city of Milwaukee, is hereby fixed at three thousand dollars per annum.

SECTION 2. The salary of the deputy chief clerk of the city of Milwaukee, is hereby fixed at fifteen hundred dollars per annum.

SECTION 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
