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CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT to annex the village of Bay View to the city of Milwaukee, and to fix the terms of annexation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Annexing Bay View village to the city of Milwaukee.

SECTION. The territory embraced in the corporate limits of the village of Bay View, described as follows: All the southeast fractional one-quarter of section ten; all of the northwest fractional one-quarter of section ten; all of the southwest fractional one-quarter of section ten; all of the northeast fractional one-quarter of section nine; all of the northwest one-quarter of section nine; all of the southeast one-quarter of section nine; and all of east one-half of the southwest one-quarter of section nine; all in towns six north, of range twenty-two east, of the fourth principal meridian, Milwaukee county, state of Wisconsin, shall be and hereby is annexed to the city of Milwaukee, on the terms hereinafter provided.

Creating 17th ward.

SECTION 2. The territory described in section 1, of this act, subject to change of boundary, shall constitute and be known as the Seventeenth ward of the city of Milwaukee, and the territory, property, and inhabitants thereof, shall have and enjoy all the rights, privileges, immunities, and powers, and be subject to the same laws and ordinances as other wards of said city.

To constitute one sewerage district.

SECTION 3. The territory described in section 1, of this act, shall constitute one sewerage district, to be known as the Bay View sewerage district, and all taxes collected for sewerage purposes therein shall be assessed, levied, collected and expended in said district, the same as other sewerage districts of said city, except general sewerage taxes, which shall be levied, collected and disposed of as in other cases.

Certain property of village conveyed to city.

SECTION 4. The property now owned by the village of Bay View, described as block four, Mann's subdivision in Bay View, and all other

property, both real and personal, owned by said village, shall be and hereby is conveyed to the city of Milwaukee, and all right, title, and interest of said village therein, shall be and hereby is vested in the city of Milwaukee.

SECTION 5. All funds in the hands of the treasurer of the village of Bay View, at the time of such annexation, and all taxes now due said village, and to be collected thereafter, shall be paid into the treasury of the city of Milwaukee, and shall be placed to the credit of such ward for local or sewerage purposes as shall be directed by the common council of said city.

Funds in hands of treasurer, etc., to be paid into treasury of city of Milwaukee.

SECTION 6. All funds now in the hands of the treasurer of school district number one, of the town of Lake, said school district being the same territory described in section 1, of this act, at the time of annexation, and all taxes now due said school district and to be collected thereafter, shall be paid into the treasury of the city of Milwaukee, to be used and expended for school purposes in said ward the same as school moneys are expended in other wards of said city, and the city of Milwaukee shall maintain the public schools in said ward created for the current year.

School funds to be paid into city treasury and expended in ward hereby created.

SECTION 7. The grades heretofore fixed and established on all improved streets in the territory described in section 1 of this act, shall be and remain the established grades of such streets with the same force and effect as if such grades had been fixed and established by the city of Milwaukee.

Grades of streets to remain unchanged.

SECTION 8. The records, books, plats and public documents of, and relating to the government of the village of Bay View, shall be delivered to the proper officer of the city of Milwaukee to be kept and stored with the records of said city.

Records, books, plats and public documents of and relating to village to be delivered to proper city officer.

SECTION 9. The territory described in section 1, of this act shall for the purpose of electing a justice of the peace and a constable, constitute the eleventh district, and the justice of the peace now in office in said district shall continue to hold to the end of his term, and thereafter there shall be elected in said district a justice of the peace and a constable as in other districts of said city.

Annexed territory to constitute 11th district and the justice of the peace now in office in said district to continue to hold.

SECTION 10. At the next annual charter election in the city of Milwaukee, there shall be elected in the said ward hereby created, one alderman, who

shall hold his office for the term of one year; one alderman who shall hold his office for the term of two years; one alderman who shall hold his office for the term of three years; one supervisor, whose term of office shall expire at the same time as the supervisors in other odd-numbered wards of said city, and one constable, who shall hold his office for the term of one year; and it shall be the duty of the mayor of the city of Milwaukee, within five days after the passage and publication of this act, to divide the ward hereby created into election districts or precincts, forming them, as near as can be practically ascertained, to poll not more than eight hundred votes, and to designate and provide suitable places for holding said election therein, and to appoint the usual number of inspectors and clerks of election in each of said election precincts; and he shall forthwith thereafter certify the same to the city clerk of said city of Milwaukee, and the election for said aldermen and other officers shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in the manner provided by law.

Assessor to be appointed by mayor.

SECTION 11. It shall be the duty of the mayor of the city of Milwaukee, within thirty days from and after the passage and publication of this act, to appoint an assessor for the said Seventeenth ward hereby created.

School commissioner to be appointed by common council.

SECTION 12. It is hereby made the duty of the common council of the city of Milwaukee, within thirty days from and after the passage and publication of this act, to appoint two school commissioners for said Seventeenth ward hereby created, one who shall hold his office for the term of one year, and one who shall hold his office for the term of two years, and thereafter their successors shall be appointed in the manner provided by law for the appointment of school commissioners in other wards of said city.

SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
