CHAPTER 455.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Milwaukee to raise a special tax in the south sewerage district of said city.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of Milwaukee, is hereby authorized to levy and raise by taxation upon all the taxable property, real and personal, within the south sewerage district of said city, in addition to the amount authorized to be raised for a sewerage fund in said district, and in addition to the amount of money authorized to be raised by taxation for all purposes within said district, now limited by law, for each of the years 1888, and 1889, a sum of money not exceeding one mill on the dollar, in each of said years, upon all of the taxable property within said district, for the purpose of constructing a main sewer on and along Beecher street, from the west dock line of the Kinnickinnick river, westward through the twelfth and fourteenth wards of the city, as contemplated by the plans now on file in the offices of the proper officers of said city of Milwaukee, or as the same may be amended, in the proper way hereafter, and for the construction of such other main sewers in the south sewerage district of the said city, as may be found necessary after the aforesaid sewer shall have been constructed as far westward as ninth avenue, in the fourteenth ward of the city of Milwaukee.

City of Milwaukee may levy tax in south sewerage district.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
