CHAPTER 70.

AN ACT to authorize W. H. Richards, to erect and maintain a dam across the Big Eau Pleine river, in the county of Marathon.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. W. H. Richards his heirs and as Authorizing signs, are hereby authorized and empowered to to build a dam. erect, keep up and maintain a dam across the Big Eau Pleine river, on the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section number four, in township number twenty seven, north of range number three, in the county of Marathon, on lands owned by the said W. H. Richards, said dam not to exceed nine feet in height.

SECTION 2. The aforesaid W. H. Richards, his To build suitaassociates, heirs and assigns, shall build suitable ble slides, etc. slides in said dam for running logs and timber over the same and shall keep the same in repair. The same shall be kept open at all times when said river is at a driving stage, and there are logs or timber to be run over said dam.

SECTION 3. The dam so erected shall be subject to provisions to all the provisions of chapter 146, of the revised of chapter 146, statutes and acts amendatory thereof, so far as said chapter and acts amendatory may be applied, in like manner as if such provisions were incorporated in this act.

SECTION 4. The right to alter, amend or repeal Right to amend this act is hereby reserved.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
