CHAPTER 278.

AN ACT to amend section 1, of chapter 201, of the laws of 1882, in relation to fences.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Amend section 1, chapter 201, by Amending ch. adding at the end of said section the following: owner of swine Provided, that this act shall not be construed to damages. relieve the owner of swine from any damage they may commit upon enclosed premises of an adjoining owner.

CHAPTER 279.

AN ACT relating to the rate of interest on trust funds.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The commissioners of public lands Rate of interest of the state of Wisconsin, are hereby authorized and empowered to loan the trust funds of the state, at a rate of interest not less than five per centum per annum; provided, all such loans shall be made in accordance with the provisions of chapter 17, of the revised statutes and the several acts amendatory thereof.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
