## CHAPTER 363.

AN ACT to amend subdivision 11, section 1038, chapter 48, of the revised statutes of 1878, entitled. "of assessment of taxes."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Amending  
subd. 11, sec.  
1038, R. S.

SECTION 1. Subdivision 11, of section 1038, chapter 48, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by inserting the words, "and other household furniture not exceeding in value the sum of two hundred dollars" after the word, "kitchen furniture," where it appears in said subdivision, so that it reads when amended as follows: Wearing apparel, family portraits, libraries, kitchen furniture, and other household furniture, not exceeding in value the sum of two hundred dollars, and also growing crops.

Exempting \$300  
worth of house-  
hold furniture  
from taxation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 364.

AN ACT to preserve and protect fish in Green Lake county, including all streams, creeks, sloughs, bayous, marshes and waters adjacent and tributary to said Green Lake.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Nets or snares  
not to used in  
Green Lake.

SECTION 1. No person or persons shall set, place or use any gill, fyke, pound, seine, dip or other net or snare, or cause the same to be set, placed or used, in Green Lake, in Green Lake county, including all streams, creeks, sloughs, bayous,
