**CHAPTER 375.**

AN ACT relating to electric light companies.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of each and every electric light and power company, and of each and every person engaged in the transmission of electrical energy within this state, to provide by suitable insulation, return wires or other means against injury to persons or property by leakage, escape or induction of any and every current of electricity.

Electric light companies to provide against injury to persons and property.

SECTION 2. Neglect of any of the above provisions shall entitle the person or corporation injured thereby to a preliminary injunction, preventing further use of such current until said section 1, has been complied with.

Injunction may be had for neglect.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 15, 1889.
