CHAPTER 151.

AN ACT to amend chapter 3, of chapter 159, of the laws of Wisconsin for the year 1885, entitled, "An act to revise, codify and amend chapter 278, laws of 1874, entitled, 'An act to incorporate the city of Shawano,'" and the several acts amendatory thereof.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 8, of chapter 3, of chapter 159, of the laws of 1885, is hereby amended, so that said section, when amended, shall read as follows: Section 8. The elective officers of said city shall be a mayor, a city clerk, a city treasurer, a city assessor, and a police justice to be elected for the city at large, by the qualified electors of said city. The elective officers of each ward of said city shall be two aldermen, a justice of the peace, a supervisor and a constable, to be elected by the qualified electors of each ward of said city.

SECTION 2. Section 16 of chapter 3, of chapter 159, of the laws of 1885, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 16. At the first meeting of the common council in each year, after the annual city election, or as soon thereafter as may be practicable, the mayor may appoint a city marshal, a city attorney, a city physician, a chief engineer and one assistant engineer of the fire department, and a city superintendent of streets, and such other officers as the ordinance may prescribe, subject to the approval of a majority of the common council.
