CHAPTER 347.

AN ACT to appropriate to John Fetzer a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to John Fetzer, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two thousand dollars, in full for expenses incurred by him in contesting for the office of state senator for the first senate district.

Appropriation to John Fetzer for expense, contest of seat.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 348.

AN ACT to appropriate to Hon. E. Scofield a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to Hon. E. Scofield the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars in full, for expenses incurred by him in contesting for the office of state senator for the first district.

Appropriation to E. Scofield for expense, contest of seat.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
