CHAPTER 117.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to the Wisconsin State Horticultural Society.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of fifteen hundred dollars out of the general fund, annually, to the Wisconsin State Horticultural Society, in lieu of all other appropriations to said society.

CHAPTER 118.

AN ACT to amend chapter 424, of the private and local laws of 1866, entitled "An act to aid in the development of the manufacturing interests of this state."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 424, of the private and local laws of 1866, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 1. The successors or assigns of the Kilbourn Manufacturing company or the riparian owners, or their assigns, shall have power and they are hereby authorized to complete the water power on sections three, four, nine and ten, in township thirteen

north, of range six east, in the counties of Columbia and Sauk, by raising the dam a sufficient height for that purpose, in the Wisconsin river, not exceeding ten feet above usual low water mark.

CHAPTER 119.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 282, laws of Wisconsin for 1891.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
