CHAPTER 123.

AN ACT to authorize and empower Charles D. Stanhope, Charles R. Gether, and the North Lawndale company, to construct a pier, dock or wharf into Lake Michigan, in Milwaukee county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Charles D. Stanhope, Charles R. Gether, and the North Lawndale company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the state of Wisconsin, their and its associates, executors, heirs, successors and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to build and maintain a pier, dock or wharf extending into Lake Michigan from or on the lands now owned by said Charles D. Stanhope, Charles R. Gether, and the North Lawndale company, or either of them, known and described as the south half of the northwest fractional quarter of section number twenty-eight, township number eight north, of range number twenty-two east, in the said county of Milwaukee, state of Wisconsin. Said pier, dock or wharf is to be used for the loading and unloading of vessels or other water craft, or for any other necessary and proper purposes, and is not to extend into said Lake Michigan for a distance of over one thousand feet.
