CHAPTER 139.

AN ACT authorizing the building of a dock or pier in Sturgeon Bay.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

C. M. Whiteside, et al.,
authorized to
build dock.

SECTION 1. C. M. Whiteside, L. C. Thorkildson, and A. Shaw, co-partners as Whiteside, Thorkildson and Shaw, their heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to build and maintain a dock or pier extending into the waters of Sturgeon Bay, from lot two, subdivision seventy-six, in the city of Sturgeon Bay.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication, but the legislature reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal this act at any time.

CHAPTER 140.

AN ACT to amend chapter 433, of the laws of 1891, and to appropriate a sum of money therein named to the "State Board of World's Fair Managers."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of World's Fair Managers for carrying out the provisions and purposes expressed in chapter 433, of the laws of 1891, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars, to be paid out by the state treasurer to the treasurer of
