CHAPTER 251.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Sheboygan to construct a bridge across Sheboygan river.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The city of Sheboygan is hereby authorized to build, construct and maintain a wagon bridge over and across the Sheboygan river at Eighth street, in said city, and for that purpose may erect piers, drive piles, sink cribs, and build approaches in said river and banks thereof, necessary for the proper or convenient construction and maintenance of such bridge; provided, that a suitable draw shall be built and maintained in the channel span of such bridge for the passage of boats; and said bridge shall be so constructed as not to materially interfere with the navigation of the waters of the said Sheboygan river; and provided further, that said bridge shall be constructed according to plans approved by the secretary of war of the United States.
