CHAPTER 252.

AN ACT to amend section 1, of chapter 233, of the laws of 1881, as amended by chapter 105, of the laws of 1889, relating to the care of the chronic insane.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 233, of the laws of 1881, as amended by chapter 105, of the laws of 1889, is hereby amended by adding to said section the following: The board of supervisors of any county in the state, with the consent of the state board of control, is hereby authorized to purchase a proper site within said county for an asylum for the chronic insane, and to erect thereon, upon plans, drawings and specifications to be approved by said state board of control, suitable buildings for the care of such insane, and to levy taxes and issue bonds to defray the cost of purchasing such site and erecting such buildings and maintaining the same.

SECTION 2. All previous acts of the board of supervisors of any county in the state referring to the purchase of a site and the erection of an asylum thereon for the chronic insane are hereby legalized.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
