CHAPTER 115.

AN ACT authorizing county boards to vote aid to agricultural societies to purchase fair grounds.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Any county board in this state is hereby authorized to vote aid to an agricultural society, if one be organized in the county, to assist said county to purchase fair grounds, to an amount not exceeding five hundred dollars.

CHAPTER 116.

AN ACT relating to the correction of errors in making charges for care of insane.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter 229, of the laws of 1881, shall be deemed to extend and be applicable to all charges that have been or are hereafter made against any county for the care of persons confined in county hospitals as fully as to those made for care of persons confined in the two state hospitals.
