## CHAPTER 234.

**AN ACT** to authorize Maitland H. Wilcox to erect, maintain and keep a dam across a spring brook in Dunn county, Wisconsin.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** Maitland H. Wilcox, his associates, heirs and assigns are hereby authorized to erect, maintain and keep a dam not more than five feet high, across a spring brook, a tributary of Gilbert Creek, in Dunn county, Wisconsin, on the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section twenty-six, in township twenty-eight, north, of range fourteen, west, for the purpose of hatching, propagating and raising fish; provided, however, that no fishway shall be required in said dam.

Relating to a dam across a spring brook, Dunn Co.

**SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
