

the population, climate, soil, products, agricultural, mineral and other resources and advantages of this state, and for the printing, distribution and dissemination thereof, in such form and in such languages, as it may deem expedient and for the best interests of the state.

SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated, out of the general fund in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of four thousand dollars annually for the years of 1897 and 1898, to be drawn on the order of the governor and secretary of state, to be by them expended pursuant to and under the provisions of this act. \$4,000 annual appropriated.

SECTION 6. The term of office of said board shall cease and determine on the first day of April, 1899, and this act shall cease to be of force and effect from and after the first day of April, 1899. Term to cease April 1, 1899.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 328.

AN ACT relating to the fees of sheriffs and other officers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The sheriff or other officer who shall execute a commitment to state school for dependent and neglected children, or any state industrial school in this state, shall be entitled Fees to officers to execute a commitment to the state school.

to receive therefor, from the proper county, his actual and necessary expenses, and the further sum of five dollars and no more, for each day while necessarily engaged in executing such commitment.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 329.

AN ACT to prohibit the sale of cigarettes and cigarette paper to minors.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Sale of cigarettes to minors prohibited.

SECTION 1. Any person or persons who shall sell, vend or in any way deal or traffic in, or otherwise dispose of or give away, any cigarettes or cigarette paper in any quantity whatsoever, to, or with a minor under the age of twenty-one years, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and, on conviction thereof, shall be punished therefor by a fine of not less than five dollars (\$5) or more than twenty-five dollars (\$25) for each offense, besides the costs of suit, or by imprisonment in the county jail of the proper county not less than five days or more than thirty days; and, in case of a second or any subsequent conviction of the same person, the punishment shall be by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25) or more than one hundred dollars (\$100), besides the costs of suit, or by imprisonment in the county jail of the proper
