

the first day of June next ensuing in each year, cause all such dams, booms, piers or other obstructions to be examined and cause complaint in the proper court to be made against any person or persons violating the provisions of this act.

SECTION 3. Any person or persons who shall neglect or refuse to construct or keep in repair or keep open a fishway as required by the provisions of this act, shall upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars and cost of suit for each and every such offense; one-half of the fine shall be paid to the complaining witness.

Penalty for failure to maintain fishways.

SECTION 4. The right of the legislature to repeal or amend this act is hereby reserved.

SECTION 5. All acts or parts of acts, in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 208.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to the Wisconsin State Horticultural Society.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of three hundred dollars out of the general fund, to the Wisconsin State Horticultural society, to reimburse it for expenses incurred in

making an exhibit of Wisconsin fruits at the Trans-Mississippi and International Exposition, at Omaha, Nebraska, during the year 1898.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 209.

AN ACT to authorize Angus J. McGilvray, his heirs, associates and assigns, to build and maintain a dam across the Chippewa river, in Chippewa county, state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Angus J. McGilvray, of Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin, his heirs, associates and assigns, are hereby authorized to build and maintain a dam across the Chippewa river, at any point he or they may select on section thirty, or on sections twenty-nine and thirty, in township thirty north, of range seven west, and to use the water of said river for the purpose of operating any and all kinds of machinery he or they may hereafter see fit to erect, and to sell or lease the right to use said water and water power, created by said dam, to any person or persons whomsoever; provided, said dam, if built north of the east and west quarter line of said section thirty, shall not exceed fourteen feet in height above low water mark, and if built south of said quarter line, said dam shall not exceed thirty feet in height above low water
