CHAPTER 280.

AN ACT to authorize Waushara county to aid the Waushara County Agricultural society in the erection of buildings and for the other purposes of the society.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The board of supervisors of the county of Waushara, in the state of Wisconsin, are hereby authorized and empowered to appropriate a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars in any one year, to aid and assist the Waushara County Agricultural society, a duly organized and incorporated agricultural society, in said county, in the erection of fences, sheds and fair buildings on lands owned or used and occupied by said society in the village of Wautoma and for other purposes of said society, upon such terms and conditions as to the said county board may seem just and proper; said buildings and improvements in grounds to be used for the purpose of holding annual fairs and exhibitions of an agricultural nature for the benefit of the people of said county.

County board authorized to appropriate \$500 annually to aid society.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
