## CHAPTER 308.

AN ACT to amend chapter 46 of the Wisconsin statutes for 1898 relative to the duties of assessors and sections 1211, 1212 and 1795 of said statutes.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 46 of the Wisconsin stat-Assessor to collect rail-utes for 1898 is hereby amended by inserting in mad statissaid chapter immediately after section 1010, four new sections which shall be known and read as follows: Section 1010a. It shall be the duty of the assessor in each assessing district in the state to make a certified report of the following data, concerning all railroads, public, private, logging or other kind located in his district, either steam or electric, to-wit: name, owner, operator. Section 1010b. On or before the first day of June of To report to each year each assessor shall transmit such re- railroad comport to the railroad commissioner at Madison, and file a copy of the same with the town, city or village clerk wherein his assessing district is located. Section 1010c. The secretary of state is Secretary of hereby authorized and instructed to procure the nish blanks. blanks necessary to the provision of this act and to transmit the same to the several county clerks of the state who shall immediately transmit the same to the several assessors of his county. Section 1010d. Any assessor neglecting or refusing Penalty for to make the report provided for in this act shall assessor be punished by a fine of not less than fifty dollars.

SECTION 2. Section 1211 of the Wisconsin statutes for 1898 is hereby amended by striking out the word "February," where it occurs in the third line of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the word "March," so that said section when so

amended shall read as follows : Section 1211. Every steam or electric railroad company and every person operating a railroad in this state, except railroads operated by horse power or city street railroads wholly within such city shall, on or before the tenth day of March in each year, make and return to the state treasurer in such form and upon such blanks as shall be furnished by him, a true statement of the gross earnings of their respective roads for the preceding calendar year, of the number of miles of road operated by each such company or person and the gross earning per mile per annum during such year; which statement shall be verified by the oath of the secretary and treasurer of such companies or of the person so operating such railroad.

Duties of railroad commissioner.

Application for license. SECTION 3. Section 1795 of the Wisconsin statutes for 1898 is hereby amended as follows: first by striking out the word "February" in the second line of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the word "March," and by striking out the word "oddnumber" where it occurs in the twenty-fourth line of subdivision four (4) of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the word even numbered.

SECTION 4. Section 1212 of the Wisconsin statutes for 1898 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "thereupon" in the fourth line of said section the following: "if such statement be approved by the railroad commissioner." so that said section when so amended shall read as follows: Section 1212. Each such railroad company and each person operating any railroads shall on returning such statement, apply for a license to operate the railroad mentioned in such statement, and shall pay the license fee therefor provided in the next section; and thereupon, if such statement be approved by the railroad commissioner shall receive from the state treasurer a license to operate such railroad for the calendar year commencing on the first day of January preceding and terminating on the next succeeding

thirty-first day of December, unless sooner revoked.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 309.

AN ACT relating to municipalities and amendatory of section 942 of the statutes of Wisconsin for the year 1898.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 942 of the statutes of the Municipal state of Wisconsin for the year 1898, is hereby poses for amended by inserting after the word "purpose" which may issue. in the seventh line thereof, the words "and for the purchase, construction, maintenance and operation of telephone lines and exchanges," and by adding a new section to be known as section 942a, so that said section 942, when amended, and 942a, shall read said section as follows: Section 942. Any county, town, village or city may, in accordance with the provisions of this chapter, issue its negotiable bonds for the purpose of paying for any authorized subscription to the stock or mortgage bonds, or both, issued by any corporation or company organized for building any railroad, whether of broad, ordinary or narrow gauge, or made of iron, steel or wooden rails, or in exchange for or compromise of any such bonds previously issued for such purpose, and for the purchase, construction, maintenance and op-
